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Bulletin of Semi Government Sector Employment – 2009

Annual Data Collection of Employment Statistics in Semi Government Sector

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Introduction

- Department of Census and Statistics conducts the annual data collection of Employment Statistics in Semi Government Sector since 1966 as at 31st December.
- Information on employees working under Corporations, Statutory Boards, Authorities, State Banks, Universities and Public Private Companies were collected under the Semi Government.
- Data is collected through the postal enquiry by a questionnaire filled by the Semi Government institutions.
- This questionnaire is designed to collect information about employee's Sex, Status of Appointment and Occupational Categories.
- Semi Government Sector consists 248 institutions in year 2009 and out of them 14 institutions have not responded.
- The list of semi government 2009 is updated by the last Employment Census 2006.
- This is the only source of data on Field Estate Labourers.

The total number of employees in semi government sector has shown a decrease during the period, 2003 to 2009 mainly due to the closing down of some of the institutions. Since semi government sector consists mostly industrial oriented occupations it has higher number of male employees. As shown in Table 1, the number of male employees are more than twice the female employees.

Figure 1: Distribution of Semi – Government Sector Employees by Sex 2003 - 2009

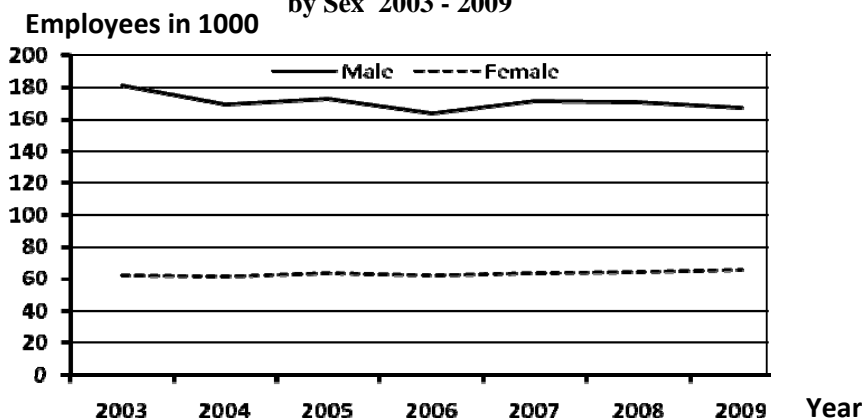

Figure 2: Distribution of Semi Government Sector Employees by Status of Appointment 2003 - 2009

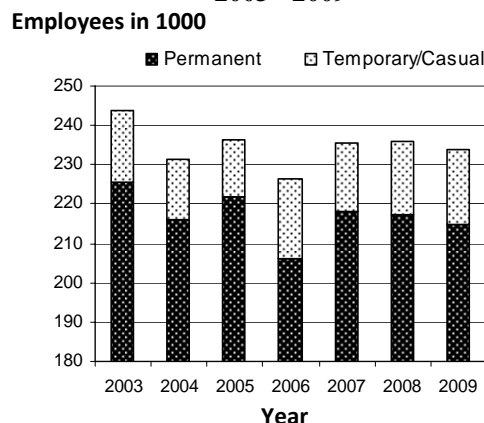
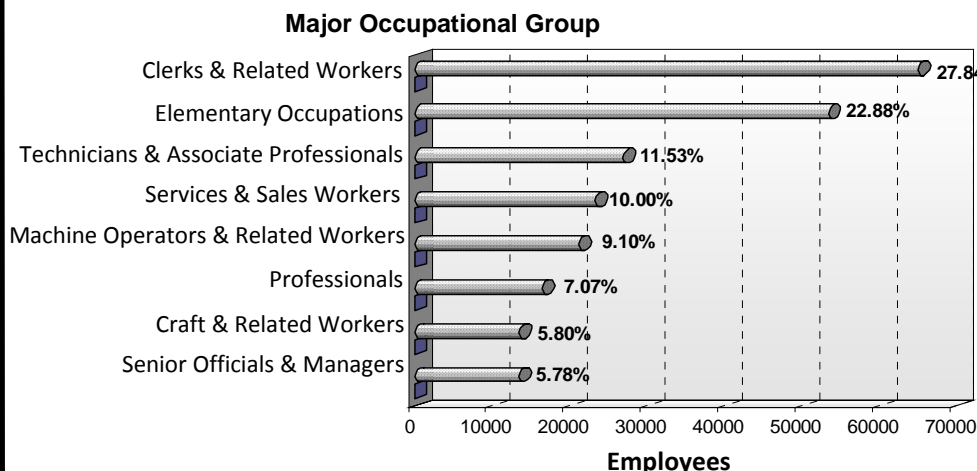

Figure 3: Percentage Distribution of Semi – Government Sector employees by Major Occupational Group - 2009

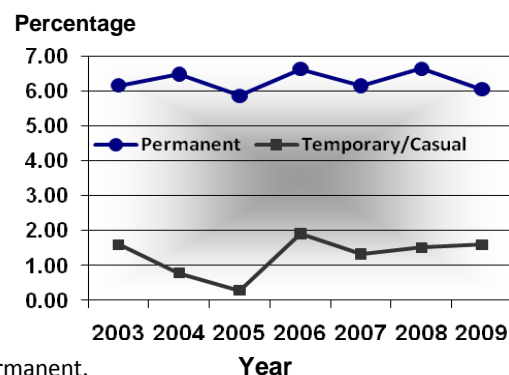


- The highest percentage of employees (28%) are reported as Clerks and related Workers.
